

PICKLEBALL SPORTS COURT DIMENSIONS

Pickleball is a game played between either two players (singles) or four players (doubles). Players use a solid faced paddle to strike a plastic wiffle ball over the net and into the opponent's court.

The court

The court rectangle, 44ft in length and 20ft in width. The same size court is used for both singles and doubles.

Often the court color, no volley area (kitchen) and court surrounds are different colors.

The court is divided across the middle by a net that is suspended at a height of 36inches and each net post. The center strap hold the net at 34 inches in the center.

Lines

All court measurements are made to the outside of the lines and all lines of the courts should be of the same color. The width of each line should be 2 inches.

Base lines are at each end of the court and are situated 22ft from the net and are a total of 20ft long.

The non-volley line runs in the same direction as the baseline and is situated 7ft from the net and 15ft from the baseline.

Sidelines run from the edge of each baseline are also met by the non-volley line.

The center service line joins the non-volley line and the baseline and is situated in the middle of the court. 10ft from each sideline.

Court surrounds

It is recommended that the full size of the pad (court plus surrounds) be atleast 24ft by 54ft. Ideally and if space allows the total area should be 30ft by 60ft.
